Admissions Calendar

November 2018 to the end of January 2019:

The School accepts applications via its website or by post. A confirmation email will be sent to parents when the full application is received. Only completed application forms submitted with the required fees will be reviewed.

February 2019:

The School reviews all completed applications.

March 2019:

The School will contact parents if a space is available for their child. Both parents and the child must attend this meeting which will last about thirty minutes.

April 2019:

Families are contacted with an acceptance letter or an opportunity to join a waiting list.

Factors considered when reviewing an application:

- Class composition (age/gender/language balance) and indications that the Montessori education is a preferred method of instruction for the family.
- Preference is given to siblings of current students and children transferring from another Montessori school.
- Children must be toilet independent to enter the Children's House program.
